



## National Institute for Jewish Hospice

### Training and Accreditation Fees

For hospices, hospitals, nursing homes, synagogues or any facility or program created to care for the Jewish terminally ill.

For a facility or organization to receive NIJH Accreditation for one year, the following components must be included:

1. Signed accreditation application by the organization.
2. Training session with the staff, including leadership, nurses, clergy, volunteers and social workers. This will be a four to five hour training session.
3. The purchase of all NIJH printed materials and tapes (not required for re-accrediting hospices.)
4. The organization must place an ad and/or article in local Anglo Jewish newspapers noting accreditation by the NIJH.
5. Photographs may be taken at training for further use in publicity and the Jewish Hospice Times.

#### Accreditation Fees:

First time accreditation training session with lunch break:	\$2,500.00
Re-accreditation training session with lunch break	\$1500.00
Registration fee for each member:	\$100.00
